CGM Process for Florida Blue Medicare Members

Purpose of this communication:

To inform providers how to handle CGM services for Florida Blue Medicare members.

What do I need to know?

- Beginning January 1, 2023, Florida Blue transitioned the provision of all therapeutic CGM services (K0553 & K0554, E2103 & A4239, and E2102/A4238) to pharmacies for Medicare members.
- CGMs and related supplies will be fulfilled by the pharmacy but will remain covered under the medical benefit, <u>not the pharmacy benefit</u>.
 - These products are still covered under the medical (DME) benefit but are distributed by pharmacies.
- Claims with dates of service through March 31, 2023, where the authorization requests were submitted to and approved by CareCentrix for starts of care December 31, 2022 or prior, should be billed to CareCentrix. Refer to the example table below.

• BlueCard Medicare Advantage and commercial members are not impacted by this change so CareCentrix will continue to coordinate CGMs for these members.
