

REMINDER – Requirements for Variable Rate Codes

Purpose of this communication:

- To remind Florida Blue and Horizon providers of documentation requirements when submitting a registration/authorization request for variable rate codes.

What do I need to know?

- A variable rate code is a code in your contract that does not have a fixed dollar amount specified in your contract. For example, the rate is reflected as MSRP minus XX%.
- Providers submitting registration/authorization requests for variable rate codes **MUST** provide an itemized invoice that includes sufficient details to identify the requested item(s), such as product name, item or part number, description, brand or model information, and MSRP (if available).
- Failure to submit the required documentation may result in delayed processing of a request or claim payment.

What do I need to do?

- Providers submitting registration/authorization requests for variable rate codes must ensure all required documentation is uploaded at the time of entering a registration/authorization request.
