

FDA Recall – Abbott: Ready-to-Feed Liquid Products

Purpose of this communication:

We are writing to inform you that the FDA has issued notice of a voluntary recall by Abbott of certain lots of 2 fluid ounce/59 milliliters bottles of Ready-to-Feed liquid products for infants and children, including the brands Similac Pro-Total Comfort, Similac 360 Total Care, Similac 360 Total Care Sensitive, Similac Special Care 24, Similac Stage 1, Similac NeoSure, Similac Water (sterilized) and Pedialyte Electrolyte Solution due to a small percentage of bottles (less than 1%) in the recalled lots have bottle caps that may not have sealed completely which could result in spoilage. The products included in the recall were manufactured at the Columbus, Ohio manufacturing facility. This recall does not include any other liquid or powder formula brands or other nutrition products produced in Abbott's Columbus facility or elsewhere within Abbott's global nutrition manufacturing network, and does not include any amino acid-based formulas or metabolic nutrition formulas.
