


Changes to Florida Blue Patient Intake and Authorization Numbers

Purpose of this communication:


- To provide information regarding a change to the intake and authorization numbers for certain patients covered under Florida Blue plans.

What do I need to know?

- This change only affects patients covered under the Blue Options Metals plan. The intake and authorization numbers associated with these patients is changing. All other information associated with the old intake(s) and authorization(s) will remain the same.
- The new intake and authorization numbers can be found on the Provider Portal: HomeBridgeSM (<https://www.carecentrixportal.com>) by searching for the “Authorization Status”.
 - Once you are on the “Find an Auth Status” screen, you may search for the patient using their first name, last name, date of birth (DOB), insurance name, subscriber ID, zip code, and city. This information from the prior intake and authorization remains the same. The new intake and authorization number for the identified patient will be provided on the following screen.
