New Blue Cross Blue Shield Alphanumeric Subscriber IDs

Purpose of this communication:

- Effective immediately, the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association (BCBSA) is expanding the alpha prefix designation to accommodate alphanumeric values in Subscriber IDs.
 - o Example of a new Subscriber ID: W5K123456789

What do I need to know?

- New prefixes are required due to the growing BCBS membership.
- Alpha prefix Subscriber IDs will be exhausted in early 2018.
- The following order will be released one set at a time:
 - (A=Alpha, N=Numeric)
 - o Set 1 ANA
 - o Set 2 NAA
 - o Set 3 NNA
 - o Set 4 AAN
 - o Set 5 NAN
 - o Set 6 ANN

What do I need to do?

• Validate that all internal systems are capable of accommodating the new BCBSA prefix values.

Is there anything else I need to know?

• This only affects new BCBS members.
