Alert: Tennessee Tornado Event

Purpose of this communication:

- Severe storms and at least one devastating tornado impacted the state of Tennessee early morning Tuesday March 3rd 2020, resulting in loss of life, properties, power outages and road blocks within the state.
- Road blockages as well as 7,000+ power outages are being reported.
- Counties with the greatest impacts include Benton, Davidson, Putnam, and Wilson counties. Carroll, Fentress, Overton and Smith counties have also reported storm impacts, fallen trees, and blocked roads.

What do I need to know?
